About AfiCHI

The Afiyavest Community Health Initiative (AfiCHI) is the social impact arm of Afiyavest, dedicated to expanding access to preventive healthcare and financial protection for underserved populations across Nigeria. Through community-based interventions and innovative health financing models, AfiCHI bridges critical gaps in healthcare access by combining direct service delivery with pathways to sustainable health insurance coverage.

Program Overview

The AfiCHI Community Health Access Day – AMAC is a targeted, high-impact community health intervention designed to address critical gaps in healthcare access among underserved populations within the Abuja Municipal Area Council (AMAC).

Across many communities in AMAC, residents face persistent barriers to accessing preventive healthcare, early diagnosis, and affordable treatment. These challenges include:

- Low awareness of preventive healthcare practices
- Gaps in routine immunization sensitization
- Limited access to basic diagnostic services
- High dependence on out-of-pocket healthcare spending
- Low awareness and uptake of health insurance

This program is designed as a one-day intensive outreach intervention that delivers immediate healthcare services while creating pathways for long-term healthcare access through health insurance enrollment.

Target Communities

The intervention will focus on underserved clusters within AMAC, including:

- Nyanya / Karu informal settlements
- Jikwoyi axis
- Mpape community

A central, accessible location will be selected to maximize participation and impact.

Core Program Components

1. Preventive Health Education

Community sensitization sessions will focus on:

- Hygiene and sanitation
- Malaria prevention
- Maternal and child health
- Nutrition
- Communicable diseases
- Routine immunization awareness

2. Free Medical Outreach

On-site healthcare services will include:

- General medical consultations
- Blood pressure checks
- Blood sugar testing
- Malaria testing
- BMI and nutrition screening
- Provision of basic medications

3. Health Insurance Awareness & Sponsorship

The program integrates financial protection through:

- Education on the benefits of health insurance
- On-site enrollment support via the Afyavest platform
- Identification of vulnerable individuals
- Enrollment into sponsored health insurance schemes

Implementation Model

The program adopts a community-driven, partnership-based delivery model, leveraging:

- Local stakeholder engagement and mobilization
- Partnerships with healthcare providers and organizations
- Structured on-site service delivery
- Digital tracking and reporting through the Afyavest platform

This approach ensures efficiency, transparency, accountability, and scalability.

Key Impact Outcomes

The AfI CHI Community Health Access Day is designed to deliver both immediate and long-term impact, including:

- Direct healthcare access for 700 - 1,000 underserved individuals
- Improved early detection through 400+ diagnostic screenings
- Provision of essential medical consultations for 250–300 beneficiaries
- Increased awareness of preventive health practices and immunization
- Enrollment of 100+ vulnerable individuals into health insurance coverage
- Reduction in reliance on out-of-pocket healthcare spending
- Strengthened community trust in structured healthcare systems

Why This Matters

For many underserved communities in Abuja, access to healthcare remains limited, and financial barriers prevent timely care. This initiative addresses both dimensions:

- Immediate needs through free medical outreach and diagnostics
- Long-term protection through health insurance awareness and sponsorship

By combining access with financial protection, AfiCHI is building a sustainable pathway to improved health outcomes.
